# **Nubby Washcloth**

This is my favorite pattern for a washcloth not only for its cute appearance but also for its powerful action. The nubs on the surface add texture and are a bonus for an enhanced cleaning experience. These same features also make it an ideal and versatile pattern for use as a dishcloth.

#### **Materials:**

- Crochet Hook 4.0mm
- Dishie Worsted Weight Yarn
- Scissors
- needle

### **Abbreviations:**

ch - chain

sc - single crochet

trc - triple crochet

sl - slip stitch

sts - stitch



#### **Directions:**

- 1. ch 25
- 2. 1 ch, sc to the end
- 3. 1 ch, (sc, trc) repeat to the end of the row, last stitch should be a sc
- 4. repeat row 2 and 3 for desired size
- 5. 1 ch, sc to the end
- 6. sl and pull end of yarn through
- 7. weave ends into worked piece

## **Optional finish:**

In an alternate color sc around the outside of the cloth. This can be done 1 - 3 rounds. Add 3 sc in each corner.
